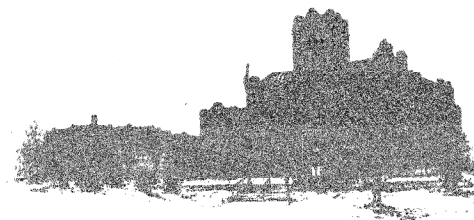

### LIBRARY CIRCULATION POLICIES

Students may have on loan up to 5 library resources for a maximum of 21 days at a time. The due date for each book is marked on a sticker inside the cover. Cameras and audio-visual equipment may only be borrowed for one day at a time.

The fine for late returns is \$0.10 per day to a maximum of \$2.00 per resource, providing the resource is returned in good condition. If an item is lost or irreparably damaged, the replacement cost must be paid by the patron.

Patrons must be in good standing with the Ballard Resource Centre, having paid all fines, in order to sign out library materials.

### STUDENT ATTENDANCE

### STUDENT FEES
