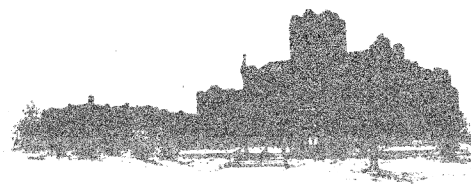

#### STUDENT-PARENT-TEACHER INTERVIEWS

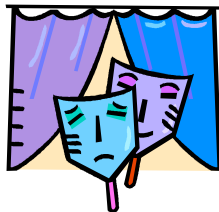
